DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING

OVERCALLS – Style and Responses

1-level: sound (occ. weak with passed partner), seldom 4-card
 2-level: sound, frequently only 5-card
 Responses: PRE jump raises, jump CUE to 3-level=mixed raise, jump 2NT=SUPP, INV+, New suit at 1-level F1,
 Reopening: may be weaker - CUE forcing

1NT OVERCALL RESPONSES

2nd:	15-18	<i>same answers as after 1NT-opening</i>
4th live:	15-18	2♣=Stayman
Reopen:	11-16, maybe no stopper	2♣=ASK range and M, others NAT

JUMP OVERCALLS

2M=4-c w longer minor
 Others weak

UNUSUAL NT

2NT=sound two-suiter (two lowest)
 Reopen: 2NT=19-21 BAL

DIRECT CUE-BID

Over NAT m-openings (=3+ cards or 1♣=4-4-3-2 or 1♦=3-3-2-5):
 2x= Sound two-suiter 55+ highest+other

Over short minor openings: 2m=NAT 2D=♥+♠

VS. NT

: 2♣=both majors 2♦=6+Maj weak
 2H/S = 6+ opening hand

Double by passed hand=S + other suit

VS. PRE-EMPTS

Dbl=T/O thru 3♦
 Against 3M: D=T/O, 4Cl/D=5+ w 5+other Major
 Two-suiters: Cue=highest unbid+lower unbid
 jump to 3M=4-c w longer minor

VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG 1♣/♦ or 2♣/♦ OPENINGS

X=both majors
 1/2NT=minors

OVER OPPONENTS' TAKE-OUT DOUBLE

after 1♣:TRF
 after 1♦: 2m=NF
 after 1♥/♠: 1NT thru 2 below opening suit=TRF;
 2NT shows support, other jumps=PRE
 after 2♣/♦/♥/♠: suit bids=NF

LEADS AND SIGNALS

LEADS

SUIT	primarily 1st / 3rd / 5th
NT	primarily 1st / 3rd / 5th
SUBSEQUENT	2nd / 4th thru declarer

From an interior sequence the third card is lead

Against suit we lead small from xxx

K asks count; at 5+ level, when OP has 3-level+ PRE or shown 10+c in two suits

Against NT sometimes 4th is led when 3rd is a high small card

In partner's supported suit we may lead highest from xxxx

3+M unless 17+ except (1♠)-DBL-(P)-1NT(negative=0-6/7); 2ns
 CUEBID=mostly F to suit agreement

RESP DBL: 8+hcp
 (1m)-DBL-(1M)-2M=NAT

SPECIAL ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE DOUBLES

Support DBL/RDBL when RESP has 3-c support

Maximum overcall double

Most low-level doubles = T/O

Conventional defenses vs ART systems/openings
 Checkback two-way Stayman
 Many (scrambling) lebensohl 2NT bids
